2014 in Review

This January will see an anniversary - two years since the North Shore Historical Museum opened its doors to the public. This past year has been a busy one, with many events and several exhibits.

Exhibit: (December '13-February '14) **Winter Dreams** – from the Monica Randall collection, winterwear and accessories from Long Island's Gold Coast era.

(January) "*Winter Dreams*" presentation by Monica Randall.

(February) Presentation and book-signing by author Antonia Petrash: "*Long Island & the Woman Suffrage Movement*".

(April) Gilbert & Sullivan's "*Trial by Jury*", performed in the courtroom of the Museum by the *Gilbert & Sullivan Light Opera Company of Long Island*.



Exhibit: (April-June) **Next Stop, New York**. The subject of 1940s & 1950s New York life through photojournalist Arthur Leipzig's photography.

(May) Lecture and book-signing by author Stephen H. Grant: "*Collecting Shakespeare - Henry & Emily Folger*".

(July) "*Over There*" - George M. Cohan and the North Shore during World War I, by videographer Barry Rivadue.

(August) The Museum's 1907 Justices Court building was dedicated to, and named for Marguerite & Joseph Suozzi.

Exhibit: (August-January '15) **World War I — The War to End All Wars**.

(August) Dr. Richard Harris: "*World War I — Innocence, Romance & Illusion*".

(September) Dr. Richard Harris' presentation (Part II) "*World War I — Reality & Disillusionment*".



(September) Movie Night: Hitchcock's "*North by Northwest*", commemorating the 55th anniversary of the film's release, with scenes filmed in the Museum's courtroom.

(October) Lattingtown resident Harry Davison presents "*The Millionaires' Unit*", the making of a documentary about the founding of the first Naval Air Reserve during WWI.

(October) "*Endowing the Future*" - annual Museum Fund-raiser Cocktail Party at the Sea Cliff Yacht Club.

(October) Presentation and book-signing by author Robert MacKay "*Great Yachts of Long Island's North Shore*".



Exhibits and Events in the Works for 2015

The current exhibit at NSHM, **World War I - the War to End All Wars**, has been extended through January 31st, 2015. If you haven't had an opportunity to view this exhibit, you have a reprieve.

January Event - Guest Speaker Mr. Robert Pemberton, Sr. will talk about the life of Glen Cove hero Sergeant Major Dan Daly, U.S. Marine Corps, on January 21st. Daniel Joseph Daly was one of only 19 people awarded the Medal of Honor twice.



February Exhibit - A traveling exhibit sponsored by the Society for the Preservation of L.I. Antiquities (SPLIA) will be on display at the Museum, highlighting a collection of historic photographs of Long Island.

April Exhibit - This month will mark 150 years from the ending of the American Civil War with General Lee's surrender at Appomattox Courthouse in April 1865. The Museum will host an exhibit on the Civil War to commemorate this event, beginning in April.

October Exhibit - The Museum has a number of the paintings of sculptor and artist, George Gách, who maintained a studio in Roslyn. The subject of these paintings are recognizable locations on Long Island's North Shore. In October of 2015, a new exhibit will display some of Mr. Gách's paintings and newly-acquired bronze sculptures, as well as other items highlighting his work and life on the North Shore.



Other educational programs and exhibits will be scheduled throughout the year. The Membership will be advised by email and flyers as events are scheduled. Dates subject to change.
